### DIOCESAN COLLECTION

We are appealing for your support for this collection which is being held for the first time in this diocese. In K & L priest draw their salary from collection for the priests – this is standardised and capped so sufficient money is left to allow us to provide for an allowance to retired priests and assist with accommodation and healthcare. Presently we have 22 retired priests but this number is expected to rise with a resultant rise in costs. In recent years, even after reducing salaries of working priests and allowances to retired priests there has been insufficient surplus. In simple terms, we have more going out than going in. We thank people for their on-going contributions for priest collections and in particular for their support for this collection for our retired priest.
