People age 18 years and older may attend their GP or pharmacist for vaccination. People under 18 years should attend their GP. While vaccines are free to all who are aged 65 years and older and to younger people in the at-risk group, people who do not have a Medical Card or GP Visit Card will be charged a consultation fee.
