TINNAHINCH SCHOOL 1867-1971

If anyone has any old photographs, stories or history of the school contac Sean Flanagan. The school was built by local subscription in 1866/67. The school was part of Rearymore Parish, Queens County until it was transferred to Clonaslee Parish. Pupils from all over the

area attended, including some from Clonaslee and Rosenallis. The Schools Insp[ector examined as many as 62 pupils in October 1905. He also said a new map of Ireland and a clock were needed. The numbers dwindled over the years until the last Principal, Mrs Byrne retired and the school was closed in 1971. Supplies of his book "The Lost Village" have been reprinted and are now available in Hogans Shop, Clonaslee.
