At a recent meeting in County Hall, Dolores Murray represented Clonaslee. The Council have set conditions to be undertaken by a data controller. They are; all groups must be capable of installing and operating a scheme, all schemes must be part of a County Laois Federation of Group CCTV Scheme, to be set up on June 1, 2019, groups must be responsible for CCTV operation and costs, groups must comply with a CCTV code of practice, each group must reach an agreement with the Council as data controller and an approved data processor, each group remain a member of the Federation. Group representatives were required to sign the undertaking which is believed to have been run by the Department of Justice. Clonaslee is in the same position as many other groups trying to get CCTV up and going.
