One date that sticks out in my memory is the day I returned to my national school after being ordained a priest – the welcome, the atmosphere, the reception, if only all school days could have been as good! I have worked in the Cathedral of Christ the King Parish, Mullingar, for ten great years, 1988-1998 before being appointed Parish Priest here in St Mary's, taking up the appointment in September, 1998. I love it here; it has its challenges, but equally has its joys. As a priest I try to do or be nothing more than someone who is privileged to walk with a group of people in this defining time on the threshold of the twenty-first century. My walk may be slower or faster than those who have gone before, but be patient; my legs are longer than most! We look forward to having Fr Denis Nulty as our new bishop and we hope he will have many happy years with us. He becomes Bishop on August 4th in Carlow Cathedral.
